Key Projects for 2017 Billboards Reduction Program

- Outfront Media has submitted two billboard applications to the Planning Department and will be presented to the Planning Commission after the CEQA review is completed.
- The proposed locations are Langton Way (off Lewelling and Mission Blvd.) and at Arbor and A Street at 880.
- If approved, 16 billboard faces will be removed and generate revenue to the County.
- o Clear Channel will be submitting their two billboards soon.
