PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Applicant proposes expansion of the existing on-site spiritual activities including two (2-week) special events per year, with a 7,804 square foot addition to an existing prayer hall and the construction of a new 18,408 square foot dining hall with kitchen, on property located at 10200 Crow Canyon Road, Castro Valley.

PROJECT LOCATION AND ZONING:

A (Agricultural) and R-1-L-BE (Single Family Residential, Limited Agricultural Uses, 5 acre MBSA) Districts, northwest side, 100 feet west of Bellina Canyon Road, of unincorporated Alameda County, designated APNs: 085-1950-006-03, 085-1950-006-04, 085-1901-002-01, and 085-1901-002-02.
