SUBJECT: Medical Cannabis Dispensary and Cultivation Ordinances - Second reading and adoption of ordinances to allow medical cannabis dispensaries and cultivation.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Conduct the second reading and adopt the proposed ordinance amending Chapter 6.108 of the Alameda County General Code to regulate medical cannabis dispensaries, to permit and regulate the delivery of medical cannabis in the unincorporated area of Alameda County, and to regulate the sale, dispensing and delivery of edibles.
- 2. Conduct the second reading and adopt the proposed ordinance amending Sections 17.04.010, 17.06.040, 17.38.030, and 17.40.030 of Title 17 of the Alameda County General Code to conditionally permit medical cannabis dispensaries in specified districts within the unincorporated area of the County.
- 3. Conduct the second reading and adopt the proposed ordinance adding Chapter 6.106 to the Alameda County General Code to implement a pilot program authorizing and regulating the cultivation of medical cannabis in the unincorporated area of Alameda County.
- 4. Conduct the second reading and adopt the proposed ordinance amending Sections 17.04.010, 17.52.585, and 17.54.130 of Title 17 of the Alameda County General Code to implement a pilot program authorizing and regulating the cultivation of medical cannabis in the unincorporated area of Alameda County.

SUMMARY:

On August 1, 2017 the Board of Supervisors conducted the first reading of the proposed medical cannabis dispensary and cultivation ordinances. These ordinances address the local licensing provisions of Senate Bill 94, the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA).

This second reading fulfills the statutory legal requirement, and the ordinances will take effect 30 days following a favorable action by your Board. The complete ordinances are attached.
