# Subject: Upcoming Construction Activities at the Eden Landing Pump Station, at the corner of Eden Landing Road and Arden Road

This letter is to inform you that the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be constructing improvements at the Eden Landing Pump Station to replace the existing 40+ years old pump engines and associated equipment. The District will replace all four dual gas pump engines with efficient electric driven motors. The following construction information is provided for reference:

## **Anticipated Construction Schedule**

- Start date: May 21, 2012
- Duration: Construction work will be performed over two construction seasons:

Year 2012 - 165 calendar days - May thru November 2012

Year 2013 - 100 calendar days - May through September 2013

Construction hours: 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Mondays thru Sundays. No work on legal holidays.

## **During Construction Hours**

- All driveway access should be maintained; however, there may be delays depending on actual construction activities.
- Various size of construction equipment will be used to construct the necessary improvements.

## After Construction Hours

Construction equipment will be staged in designated areas on District property.

While the District continually strives to minimize construction impact to adjacent commercial offices, we also recognize the likelihood of increased noise levels during construction operations due to construction machinery and activities.
