The Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) would like to invite local residents, property owners and other interested parties to a public information meeting to learn about the Floodwall Improvement Project along the Flood Control Channel and its benefits to the adjacent community. A location map showing the project limits is attached for reference.

The proposed improvements will provide increased flood protection during high intensity storm events. The floodwall project will also benefit the local community located in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) 100-year floodplain designation as shown on the Flood Insurance Rate Map. This project when completed will enable the District to apply to FEMA a Letter of Map Revision to remove portion of the existing 100-year floodplain designation. When FEMA approves the final limits of floodplain reduction, the mandatory flood insurance purchase requirement will be removed from the affected properties.
