- § Purpose
 - Improve motorist, bicyclist, & pedestrian safety
- § Goals
 - Provide bicycle & pedestrian access



Existing Conditions

- Four lanes (two in each direction)
- Current ADT- 4,300 vehicles per day
- No sidewalks north of Carolyn Street
- Deteriorated Roadway Pavement





- Class II On-street Bicycle Lanes (Striping & Signing)
- New Concrete Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter
- Re-stripe Foothill Blvd from four travel lanes to two travel lanes
- Resurface Pavement





"GREEN" Class II On-street Bicycle Lanes





"GREEN" Class II On-street Bicycle Lanes





- Adjacent to East Hillside
- 1,300 feet (.25 miles) in length





- Re-stripe Foothill Blvd from four travel lanes to two travel lanes
- Resurface Pavement



Construction

- Traffic Delays expected during construction
- Intermittent Lane Closures required to complete construction
- No Parking during construction required to complete construction
- Access to property shall be maintained during construction – except for a limited time during sidewalk & pavement resurfacing work
