Notice of Upcoming Tree Removal Work San Leandro Creek at the end of Huff Avenue

Dear Resident,

Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be conducting tree removal and pruning work along San Leandro Creek in the vicinity of Huff Avenue. The following construction information is provided for reference:

Anticipated Construction Schedule

- Start date: Monday, November 7, 2011
- Duration: Up to two weeks, subject to change due to weather and unforeseen conditions.
- Construction hours: 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM, Mondays thru Fridays. No work on weekends.
- Truck haul route: along Huff Avenue to Callan Avenue which turns into Davis Street to I-880 Freeway. Truck hauling will take place during construction hours only.

During Construction Hours

- No parking will be allowed for approximately 300 feet from the end of Huff Avenue, to provide construction staging area.
- Construction equipment will be staged at the end of Huff Avenue.
- Various size cranes will be used to cut and lift out material, load logs on truck to haul offsite; chipping will be on-site and resulting material haul off-site.
- Trucks will be traveling in and out of Huff Avenue, hauling tree trunks and limbs.
- During the work hours, some driveway access may be temporarily restricted to accommodate the removal of large tree trunks and limbs.

After Construction Hours

- Construction equipment will be parked or staged in designated area on District property.
- ◆ Parking restrictions along curb side will be restored after 5:30 PM.
