## **Notice of Upcoming Construction Work**

## 62<sup>nd</sup> Street between Vallejo Street and San Pablo Avenue

Dear resident and property owner,

Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will be constructing flood control storm drain improvements along 62<sup>nd</sup> street. This drainage improvement will minimize the potential for flooding in the vicinity of San Pablo Avenue and 62<sup>nd</sup> Street. This portion of the improvement is the final phase of the overall storm drain improvements that started last year from the Bay through the City of Emeryville.

A public information meeting will be held on October 20, 2011, at 7:00 PM, at Ralph Hawley Middle School, located at 1275 61<sup>st</sup> Street. At the meeting, District staff will provide construction information such as parking restrictions, potential lane/road closure, and address any concerns you may have. The following construction information is provided for reference:

## **Anticipated Construction Schedule**

- Start date: October 24, 2011
- \* Estimated duration: Up to seven weeks, subject to change due to weather and unforeseen conditions
- Construction hours: 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Mondays thru Fridays. No work on weekends.

## **During Construction**

- ❖ The storm drain improvements will be along the north side of 62<sup>nd</sup> Street by the curb and gutter.
- ❖ Parking along both sides of 62<sup>nd</sup> Street, between Vallejo Street and San Pablo Avenue, will be restricted for the entire construction duration to provide construction staging area. Parking is allowed on all side streets.
- Access to driveways may be temporarily restricted to accommodate open trenching, reconstruction of curb and gutter, and asphalt concrete trench paving. Driveway access during non-construction hours will be maintained at all times.
- Local traffic will be maintained.
