Page 22 of the RFP, IV. Section S (Submittal of Bids), item 3 has been changed:

Bidders are to submit one (1) original hardcopy bid (Exhibit A – Bid Response Packet, including additional required documentation), with original ink signatures, plus $5\frac{4}{4}$ copies of their proposal.

Responses to Written Questions

- Q1) RFP No. MAO2016231 requires bidders to have at least one employee who is a certified irrigation contractor through the Irrigation Association assigned to the project. Will certifications from similar agencies be recognized?
- A1) Yes, certifications from comparable agencies will be recognized.
- Q2) Should everyone bid on the quantity of 1000 yards of mulch annually?
- A2) Yes, everyone should bid on that item.
- Q3) What type of Mulch should be used?
- A3) See page 117 of the RFP for a detailed description of the type of mulch that should be used.
- Q4) Are there any incumbent contractors for this project?
- A4) No, there is no current contract for this project.
- Q5) What is the estimated budged for this contract?
- A5) Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$ 750,000) for 3-years.
- Q6) Will the contractor be able to charge added costs for special events?
- A6) No, so long as contractor keeps regularly scheduled maintenance and East Bay Regional Park manages events.
- Q7) If a contractor comes across hazardous waste on site, how should it be handled?
