Permit General Provisions

- 1. <u>Period of Construction and Permit Expiration</u>: The authorized period of construction shall be as denoted on the face of this permit, and the term of this Permit shall expire at the end of that period. Any extension of this Permit beyond the expiration date must be approved by the Agency through a Permit amendment. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Agency reserves the right to delay final acceptance of any treatment facilities or HM measures and to unilaterally extend the Permit until the end of the rainy season (May 1) of the year following construction of these facilities or measures.
- <u>Performance Bond</u>: The Permittee shall be required to furnish an improvement security bond, in the amount indicated on the face of this Permit and in a form acceptable to the Director of Public Works, for any authorized construction of treatment facilities or HM measures. This security shall be held by the Agency pending the closeout of this Permit.
- 3. <u>Work in the Rainy Season:</u> All planned or unplanned work taking place during the rainy season (October 1 through April 30) under this Permit must be authorized by a Special Provision noted on the face of this Permit.
- 4. <u>Connection to the County Stormdrain System</u>: This Permit does <u>not</u> authorize any work in, or access to, any portion of the County Stormdrain System, consisting of the drainage systems in any public roadways, the flood control systems owned by the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), the flood control systems owned by the Zone 7 Water Agency, and those private watercourses subject to regulation under the provisions of Chapter 13.12 of the County General Ordinance Code. Any modification of, or access to, the said Stormdrain System that may be required in conjunction with any construction authorized by this Permit must be separately authorized by the responsible agency.
- 5. <u>Source Control Measures</u>: This Permit is <u>not</u> intended to authorize the installation of stormwater source control measures, as may be required by the County Building and Plumbing Codes.
- 6. <u>Construction BMP's and Inspections</u>: Any and all construction authorized by this Permit must provide protection against illicit discharge of stormwater runoff through the incorporation of a reasonable level of Best Management Practices (BMP's); however, if so designated on the face of this Permit, the application of such BMP's shall be formally verified by the Agency through periodic inspections in accordance with the requirements of Provision C.6 of Order R2-2009-0074 of the Regional Water Quality Control Board (San Francisco Bay Region).
- 7. <u>Review and Inspection Charges:</u> The actual cost of all necessary office reviews and field inspections, including the cost of any C.6 inspections (as described in General Provision 6 above), shall be charged against the deposit account described on the face of this Permit. Any cost overruns of this account must be resolved prior to close-out of this Permit. Any remaining unexpended balance in the account will be returned to the Permittee.
- 8. <u>Inspections of Authorized Work:</u> The construction of any and all treatment facilities and/or HM measures authorized by this Permit shall be subject to inspection by the Agency, and must be accepted by the Agency as part of a final inspection; see General Provision #1.
- 9. <u>Start of Work:</u> As indicated on the face of this Permit, the Agency inspector will contact the designated Site Contact Person to arrange for the required inspection prior to the planned start of work; in the event of a delay to the said start date, the Permittee shall be responsible for notifying the Agency, at least one week prior to this date, by calling (510) 670-5435.
- 10. <u>Standards of Work:</u> Any and all construction of facilities and measures shall conform to those design standards specified by the Director of Public Works on plans approved by the Director, subject to any field modifications directed by the assigned Agency inspector. All plans shall conform to the restrictions of Provision C.3 of Order R2-2009-0074 of the Regional Water Quality Control Board (San Francisco Bay Region) and shall be in general conformance with the guidelines of the latest edition of the C.3 Technical Guidance (as published by the County Clean Water Program).
- 11. <u>Changes to Permit:</u> Any changes to the terms and conditions of this Permit, or to the plans covered by this Permit, shall require the approval of the Director of Public Works, or his/her assigned representative.
- 12. Post-construction Operation and Maintenance: Any stormwater treatment facilities or HM measures authorized by this Permit shall be subject to verification of proper operation and maintenance (O&M) under a Post-Construction County O&M Verification Program. If applicable, the Permittee shall be required to file a site-specific maintenance plan as part of a recorded agreement with the Agency that must be filed with the County Recorder prior to the final inspection under this Permit. In addition to the detailed maintenance plan, the said agreement will include a right-of-entry allowing certain State and County inspectors reasonable access to the installed stormwater facilities and measures, and provisions describing the enforcement mechanisms that could be imposed by the County in the event of violation.
- 13. Indemnification of the County and District: To the fullest extent permitted by law, permittee shall indemnify the County and the District, their boards, officers, employees, and agents (collectively "Indemnittees") from and against all claims, losses, damages, liabilities, or expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees incurred in the defense thereof, for the death of or injury to any person or persons (Including the permittee's or the County's or District's employees) or damage to any property and/or business loss or harm that arises out of or is in any way connected with the issuance of this Permit or with work performed by Permittee's contractors or agents under this Permit (collectively "Liabilities"). The only exception to this duty is for those Liabilities caused solely by the negligence or willful misconduct of any Indemnitees.
- 14. <u>Suspension or Cancellation of this Permit:</u> This Permit may be suspended or canceled, at the discretion of the Director of Public Works, whenever the Permittee is failing to comply with the terms and conditions of this Permit.
